

FAMILY TREE

of the

Küblis Line of the Family Taverna

Taken from the Church Books and Civil
Documents of the Community Küblis from
Professor F. Sprecher, Küblis.

Around the year 1700 came Fährndrich Salomon Buol and Margreth, born Christ, from Davos, to the Community of Küblis. To them were born, in Küblis, the following children:

Around the year 1730 appeared in Küblis, Hans von Taverna from Davos, married, with Anna Hermann. When they arrived in Küblis they already had several children born, namely:

<u>Hans Marti</u>	:	
Margreth	:	She married on April 26, 1748 with Marti Joos from Grusch. About them is nothing more obtainable through the Church books.
Jory	:	He died, unmarried, on January 29, 1748 at the age of 32 years and was written in the death register as having referred to Davass as his home.
Elsbeth	:	She married on the exact day as her sister Margreth, with a reporter, Kasper Hartmann from Schiers. On the 15th day of July, In 1753, with his wife, a son and daughter arrived in the Community of Küblis with the sum of 360 Gulden as collateral. (There may have been a charge to move into the Community or they may have bought a home for which they needed the collateral.) This marriage produced 10 children from them, of which 5, Hans, Anna, Hans, Anna and Elsbeth died at early ages. Those who lived longer were Zya, Klas, Hans, Anna and Margret.

The ages of the 4 children who were not born In Küblis are presumable for only the dates of their baptisms are entered in the baptismal register. In 1731 is Hans Marti von Taverna, first entered in the register. In 1737, Margreth. In 1741 Jory and Elsbeth as Christians. The father, Hans von Taverna died

on December 3, 1738 at the age of 53 years and was therefore certainly in Davos born. All the records of his brothers and sisters and forebearers can be seen in the Church books of Davos. The Family lineage was saved through his son, whose name was also Hans Marti von Taverna.

The father, Hans Marti von Taverna and Katharina Buol were both born in Davass. By the time of their wedding ceremony they had not yet purchased a residence in Küblis but after a month had elapsed the purchase was made and the details written into the Community books as follows:

On May 22, 1737, Hans Marti von Taverna was sworn in to the Community of Küblis by Peter Clavadetscher, a Juror from a nearby community. Hans Marti von Taverna apparently made a down-payment of 200 Gulden for his residence in Küblis and was expected to pay the rest (approximately 160 Gulden) over a period of 12 years at 4% interest. Hans Marti von Taverna was expected to finish payments in the middle of March 1749. A total of approximately 400 Gulden, including tax, would be paid to the Government. The land he purchased was a well known and respectable place within the Community known as Plaus. He made the initial downpayment with his fathers agreement. There were three individuals who signed as witness to the attainment of the property: Rudolph Sererhard, Peter Clavadetscher a Juror, and Christian Hitz, a Community resident. Following these three signatures, Hans Marti von Taverna added his signature along with his father's signature, as an enforcer to the payment. Immediately following the swearing in of Hans Marti von Taverna,

Katharina Buol, Hans Marti's wife, was also sworn in and instructed to pay a fee of 60 Gulden, without having to pay interest until the fiscal year terminated. This document was signed by her father-in-law, Hans von Taverna. Should he not be able to make the payments for any reason, the Community would confiscate some of the goods and or property until the payment was made.

At the age of 52, Hans von Taverna became sick and died in the following Year. His son, the Community resident Hans Marti von Taverna, died on February 11, 1772. The age is not given for he was born in the year 1710, Katharina Buol had died a year earlier on November 26, 1771 at the age of 58. The lineage has survived through both of their sons (I.) Salomon and (II.) Hans Jöry von Taverna.

On January 6, 1789, Greta Täscher died at age 46. Following this, the widower Salomon von Taverna married for the second time. The wedding took place on June 24, of the same year that Greta died.

Of the 14 children who were born to Salomon von Taverna, 11 died before they had reached the age of 2 years old. Katharina from the first marriage, died as a youngster at age 19. The father also died at a relatively young age on March 30, 1795 at the age of 54. His second wife, Clara, outlived him 25 years and died on September 6, 1820 at the age of 65. She was a daughter of Luzi Juon, from Küblis, and Barbla, born Brunold, from Chur.

Salomon von Taverna was a Schoolmaster and painter. He was a perfectionist. He dictated his own work. He painted, for example, the organ housings, making inscriptions and painting the banisters in the Church of Küblis. He also undertook painting arches above the doors of some of the houses in the Community, for example, the Taverna house in the Sponda of Küblis and the Pastor's house in Conters. A rhyming poem can be found in the steeplehead of one of the churches that was renovated in 1921 in the vicinity of the Saaser Alp. This is what it says (although not exactly):

One Thousand Seven Hundred, also Seventy and Eight
A man wandered so high, that he was in the snow.
The trip to the Alps was made, on the Seventh day of June;
Very soon, he had nearly completed his trip.
But God caused a great snow to fall;
His hiking shoes were buried 6 inches in snow.
Icicles emerged from the storm that were 2 feet long,
I think that he must have been a brave man.
The snow comes as it does in the valley,
except it becomes more a challenge at higher altitudes.

Eight days after the snow, one must learn,
How the hail is transported to the Earth.
It starts In the Saaser Alps,
From there it falls heavily toward Tobal-Bach;
We travel there often,
For we must bring the cattle from the higher elevation.
On our way home we soon come into danger
Because Tobel-Bach becomes a land street.
The hail goes up as far as the Saaser step,
Four feet falls heavily upon there.

The cattle had soon become restless
One could not see his own cow very long,
One considered the hail as a charm.
For God looks on us favorably and pities us all,
Above thunder, hail and lightning he protects us as a father.
He turns us away from fear, necessity and danger,
And leads us through all of it to the chosen flock.
To those in despair have I written this poem
As something to be thankful for.

The father, Hans Marti von Taverna died May 2, 1837 at the age of 65 years, one month and 6 days from Dropsy in the chest. His wife, Maria Klas, died on January 30, 1841 at the age of 68 years, 11 months and 15 days from old age.

Salomon von Taverna died from stomach-gastric problems on May 16, 1858 when he was 55 years old. His spouse, Maria Müller, died August 29, 1805 in her 69th year.

Hans Marti died April 28, 1928 from Pneumonia.
He leaves behind no descendants.

Hans Taverna (I.1.b.) was a tobacco pipe maker. He died July 18, 1891 in his 86th year. His wife had already died, on March 10, 1878 from consumption, in her 64th year.

From (I.) Salomon von Taverna and Greta Täscher, there are no longer any living descendants in this country.

The father, Hans Jöry von Taverna died March 15, 1801 in his 54th year. His wife, Maria Janett, died January 7, 1821 at 70 years. She was born January 17, 1751, the daughter of Jakob Janett and Greta Freund, both from Küblis. Her daughter Katharina died the same day as she. The Mother, Maria Janett Taverna, the daughter, Katharina Taverna Juon and the granddaughter, Maria were laid to rest in the same grave. The mother died at 70, the daughter at 44 years and the grandchild at 24 hours old.

On the same day his daughter Luzia died from the Dysentery sickness, Jakob Taverna also died. He was 50 years, 3 months and 25 days old.

In the year 1859, from July 28 to September 13, 20 persons died from Dysentery in Küblis. The 20 people were from 3 months old to 63 Years old; 16 under 10 years of age and 4 over 10 years old (8 males and 12 females). After the death of the father--Jakob Taverna, the mother--Anna Janett--went to America with her children, Mathaus, Barbara and Zilia.

He was highly interested in finding other ways of doing things, as well as being interested, in his younger days, in the community and the valley; he started up a remarkable Parcel Service in Küblis. The Taverna House in the Sponda in Küblis, after the death of Sidonie Taverna, was sold at an auction by Jacob Taverna-Kriemler, having first the western one- half of the old duplex, the eastern half belonging to someone else in the genealogy.

This house is mine, yet not mine,
Before me it was his, but not his;
Who comes after me, must also go:
So, say I, for whom is this house?

The human genealogy has to grow as does the tree. From one root so grows the trunk, branching itself in many directions with many shoots, then builds the crown. Just like a felled tree, ones whole line will die.

Heinrich IV, King of Navarra and France in the year 1607, conferred by written letter, of the entitlement to dignity by the title given to fellow countryman Salomon Buol von Davos from the "League of the Ten Jurisdiction", for performance of meritorious service to the King.

The original translation in French is copied in order to preserve that translation and keep it in good condition for the claim of the Family Taverna.

The King has always rewarded those, in particular for good deeds, with honor and dignity and in this case for commendable action through devotion. For those who may doubt that the State and Crown has bestowed such merit, this is proof, which is of public record for all to see.

Those whose position is against us, which came to our knowledge by evidence shown to us by you, we wish not to omit our appreciation, so we are very happy to say that our loved and faithful countryman of the "League of the Ten Jurisdiction", who is always strong and loyal at every opportunity, having proved your faithful service to Ambassador - Lord Pascal, and our Country, be assured we give you full honor and the mark of nobility to uphold, and an increase in earnings, all back payments owed, which you rightfully earned by your abilities, we cheerfully give to you.

From this and other good that he's done, of which we are aware, we give the title Sir Salomon Buol of Davos, and to him, his wife and children and those to come, the dignity to issue from such title, that being bestowed on him of "Knight" of the Court.

Such dignity shall be recognized throughout the Kingdom, along with a "Coat of Arms" to carry. We also order our Minister and Treasurer, Sir Salomon Buol, never to part with this document of title. To him and his family and those to follow is granted freedom, privileges, happiness and protection to overcome most obstacles. It is our Royal wish that all of the above not be taken away for all time eternal.

This document being signed and sealed with the Royal signet ring:
Given in Paris, the 18th day of February in the merciful year 1607.

It has been noted that what is written on the Coat of Arms, has not the same dignified Information as what is written on this document of title.

That being, the "Knighting" of Sir Salomon Buol of Davos and all of the privileges that go with it as described earlier, are to go to the children, both male and female, both existing and those to come.

So the daughter of countryman Buol wishes also to bequeath on her children to come, these same privileges, dignity, protection and Coat of Arms.

Katharina Buol, daughter of Salomon Buol of Davos, was wed to Officer Second Lieutenant Hans Marti von Taverna on April 17, 1737 in Küblis, and the request she made for dignity and privileges handed down by her father, rightfully will go to such children as may come from this marriage, both male and female, but will not go to her husband, Officer Second Lieutenant Hans Marti von Taverna.
